SEMINARS & WEBINARS

 September 2019 and the eminent speakers in the Seminar were Prof. Abu Dayen (Jahangir Nagar University, Dhaka, Bangladesh) and Prof. Abhra Basu (Vishwa Bharati University, India).

renowned colleges presented their papers in the Seminar. The students also participated actively as volunteers.

The topic of the seminar was "A Comparative study between Italian Neo-Realism and French New Wave". The eminent speaker of the





seminar was Dr. Pallav Mukhopadhay, Assistant Professor, Dept. of Journalism and Mass Communication and also coordinator of Film Studies of West Bengal State University. Both the departmental student as well as the Cine and Photography club members has taken active part in this session.

infectious and vector-borne diseases. As some students come from the local community, it is a way of reaching out to the larger community.






EXTERNAL-COLLEGE PARTICIPATION








Rabindra Jayanti Celebration: Students from various departments were participated actively in the Online Rabindra Jayanti celebration on 8th May,2020.




National Science Day: An Inter-College Poster Presentation Competition was organized by


